

Canadian Regulation on Children's Sleepwear: Update on Design Restrictions for Beachwear

Health Canada has recently updated their *Children's Sleepwear: Flammability Requirement Guidelines* document regarding the maximum length criteria for children's beachwear. In the newly published document, if products such as beach robes or beach cover-ups meet the following criteria, they are exempted from the Children's Sleepwear Regulations:

- front closes the length of the garment with velcro, buttons, zipper, etc.;
- no exterior belt; and
- do not exceed the maximum lengths given in the table below.

Maximum Dimensional Criteria for the Length of a Beach Robe	
Size	Length (mm)
0 to 2	400
3 to 4	480
5 to 6X	560
7 to 10	690
12 to 14X	770

The new length requirements provide more generous measurement limits to sellers. These requirements are currently in effect.
