

New York Reinforces Bans on Flame Retardant in Childcare Products

In January 2014, New York State Assembly approved bill A4741-2013, Relates to expanding the TRIS-free children and babies act. The bill is now delivered to the Senate, and if the bill passes, the new regulation will take effect beginning December 1, 2015.

The original regulation only included TCEP (TRIS (2-chloroethyl) phosphate), but the proposed bill will expand the definition of "TRIS" to include TDCPP (TRIS (1,3-dichloro-2-propyl) phosphate).
