

EU ECHA Adds Four New Substances to the Candidate List of SVHCs



On June 25, 2020, European Chemical Agency (ECHA) has added four more substances to the Candidate List of very high concern (SVHCs). Hence, the total number of SVHCs increases from 205 to 209.

The 4 chemicals newly included and their hazard properties are as follows:

If a substance is added to SVHC candidate list, that doesn't mean it is banned but the importer and supplier of product containing a candidate list substancein a concentration above 0.1% (weight by weight) should provide sufficient information to their customers to allow safe use.
